## *Light and Light to Medium Flavored*

### **Hoyo de Monterrey Monterreyes No.4 Limited Ed 2021**

115

Vitola: Maravillas No. 4 – Smoking Time: 60 minutes

Ring Gauge 55 -- Strength Light – Length: 145 mm

*As with all Edición Limitadas since 2007, the tobacco used to make this cigar has been aged for a minimum of two years. This helps to create a more rounded and approachable flavour profile. The darker wrapper also provides a hint of sweetness that works exceptionally well with Hoyo de Monterrey's distinct light flavoured blend.*

### **H.Upmann Magnum 50**

Vitola: Magnum 50 – Smoking Time: 35 minutes

Ring Gauge 50 -- Strength Light to Medium – Length: 160 mm

*Made side by side with Montecristo in the same factory since 1937 and offering a similar bitter-sweet tanginess. Contemporary heavy gauge and far removed from the longer, slimmer formats preferred in the past.*

### **Hoyo de Monterrey Epicure No. 2**

Vitola: Robusto– Smoking Time: 45 minutes

Ring Gauge 50 -- Strength Light – Length: 124 mm

*There's a delightful nut-and-honey sweetness to this smoke, which burns evenly but has a slightly firm draw. A spicy hint of ground nutmeg really livens things up before the warm, toasty finish*

## *Medium Flavored*

### **Trinidad Vigia**

Vitola: Torres– Smoking Time: 35 minutes

Ring Gauge 54 -- Strength Medium – Length: 110 mm

*Plenty of strength by Trinidad's standards but cooled nicely by its width. Heavy leather throughout, with plenty of spice and coffee, and an underlying black pepper which gets overtaken by the other notes in time, this delicious heavy gauge smoke is a welcome addition to the brand's portfolio and hits the spot nicely when both strength and refinement are of preference.*

### **Romeo Y Julieta Short Churchill**

Vitola: Robusto – Smoking Time: 35 minutes

Ring Gauge 50 -- Strength Medium – Length: 124 mm

*For too long there was no robusto in Romeo's range, so the arrival of the Short Churchill in 2006 proved most welcome. It was the first medium flavored cigar from Cuba in this popular vitola. Hardly surprising, then that it has been a huge success.*

### **Romeo Y Julieta Wide Churchill**

Vitola: Montesco – Smoking Time: 45 minutes

Ring Gauge 55 -- Strength Medium – Length: 133 mm

*Here is one of the new generations of extra heavy weights which was released in 2010 and remains a unique size in the standard Habanos S.A. portfolio.*

### **Montecristo NO. 2**

Vitola: Pirámide– Smoking Time: 45 minutes

Ring Gauge 52 -- Strength Medium – Length: 156 mm

*If ever one brand has come to dominate a particular vitola, this is it, with this classic Pirámide or 'torpedo' size. Easy burning with a controlled release of faithful Montecristo flavors.*

*Medium Flavored***Cohiba Siglo I**

Vitola: Perla– Smoking Time: 25 minutes

Ring Gauge 40 -- Strength Medium – Length: 100 mm

*The reddish, colorado wrapper and neat triple cap make this a charming cigar to behold. The draw is open and even, as is the burn, showing a big steeped saffron note that ushers in additional layers of brioche, leather and white pepper before the floral, cedary finish.*

**Romeo Y Julieta Linea De Oro Dianas**

Vitola: Damas– Smoking Time: 60 minutes

Ring Gauge 52 -- Strength Medium – Length: 136 mm

*There is a slightly oily gleam to the wrapper of this Toro, which is made with a flat head and a three-seam cap. It draws and burns evenly, starting cedary and grassy becoming creamy with cappuccino, mocha and almond notes.*

*Medium to Full Flavored***Cohiba Siglo de Oro**

Vitola: Exitosos– Smoking Time: 25 minutes

Ring Gauge 54 -- Strength Medium to Full – Length: 114 mm

*The name of the vitola “Siglo de Oro” celebrates the Year of the Rabbit in honour of the Chinese lunar calendar as well as the 30th anniversary of the Linea 1492, one of the most successful lines of the brand.*

**Montecristo NO. 4**

Vitola: Mareva– Smoking Time: 30 minutes

Ring Gauge 42 -- Strength Medium to full – Length: 129 mm

*The most popular handmade cigar in history. Its rich, tangy, medium to full strength acts as the benchmark for most smokers embarking on the journey to find their preferred Habano.*

## *Full Flavored*

### **Partagas Serie D No. 4** **50**

Vitola: Robusto– Smoking Time: 35 minutes

Ring Gauge 50 -- Strength Full – Length: 124 mm

*The best known of all Partagas is the Serie D No. 4, the robusto size that formed part of the legendary Partagas alphabet series that dates back to the 1930's. In 2005 a Piramide, the Partagas Serie P No. 2, was added to the range, which fast became a cigar of choice amongst lovers of full flavored Habanos. In 2011 the Serie D No. 5 and the heavy ring gauge Serie E No. 2 extended the alphabet series once again.*

### **Partagas Serie P No. 2** **52**

Vitola: Piramides– Smoking Time: 60 minutes

Ring Gauge 52 -- Strength Full – Length: 156 mm

*Rich and complex, this dark, oily torpedo is a symphony of flavors that range from coconut and maple syrup to nutmeg and fresh tobacco. Everything harmonizes on the palate for a long, satisfying finish...*

### **Bolivar Belicosos Finos** **46**

Vitola: Campana – Smoking Time: 40 minutes

Ring Gauge 52 -- Strength Full – Length: 140 mm

*A deep and earthy Belicoso that comes in Cabinet Selection bundles of 25 as well as standard labelled boxes. A great choice to follow a rich in flavor meal.*

### **Ramon Allones Private Stock 230 UK RE** **108**

Vitola: Partagas 16 – Smoking Time: 70 minutes

Ring Gauge 50 -- Strength Full – Length: 170 mm

*The Ramon Allones Private Stock 230 was originally intended to celebrate the 230th Anniversary of Hunters & Frankau in 2020 released as a rare size known as a Partagás 16. This excellent cigar starts lighter than you would expect from a full-strength brand but develops into the unmistakable flavour and aroma of the Ramon Allones blend.*
